

COURTROOM DECORUM

What To Expect During Your Visit

1. All persons entering the building must undergo a security screening, which will require them to remove belts, remove items from pockets and wrists, and pass through a metal detector. Individuals may be subject to a search, including personal belongings.
2. Cell phones must be turned off before entering the courtroom.
3. No weapons are allowed in the building. This includes but is not limited to firearms, knives, needles, tasers, lighters, etc.
4. No food, drink (except water), or gum is permitted in the courthouse.
5. Running, yelling, or loud talking in the building is not permitted, especially when oral arguments are in session.
6. Smoking is prohibited in all court and government buildings. Smoking is permitted outside in designated smoking areas.
7. Attendees must not leave anything behind in the courtroom.

Courtroom Rules

8. No talking while the Court is in session.
9. No young children allowed in the courtroom.
10. No hats or bandanas.
11. Silence all cell phones and pagers.
12. No food or drink inside the courtroom.
13. No shorts or tank tops.
14. No sunglasses unless they are medically necessary.
15. No sleeping in the courtroom.
